- 3. Support the election or appointment of godly men to public office through prayer (1 Tim 2:2) and active involvement, and the removal of ungodly ones (Prov 28:12);**
- 4. Support the creation and enforcement of righteous laws and the removal or nullification of ungodly ones (1 Tim 1:8-11);**
- 5. Encourage the church with information on victories the Lord has provided (1 Thess 5:11; Heb 3:13);**
- 6. Publish resource materials for use beyond Grace Bible Church;**
- 7. While upholding the integrity and reputation of Grace Bible Church at all times.**
